- An entertaining book mainly on climbing in Skye and Scotland. The author commenced as a novice in Skye, one of a party of four, with some surprising adventures and incidentally some difficult climbing inadvertently undertaken. Fortunately for the party, their fortnight's holiday ended without over-much damage being done. Chapter 14, 'The Chasm,' is a vivid account of an ascent of Buchaille Etive Mor, described in the S.M.C. Guide as 'probably the longest and most difficult gully climb in the country.' Here again all ended well thanks to the help of a rescue party consisting of two chance motor-cyclists (bakers by trade) who had never done any mountain climbing before. Still more remarkable, they made the ascent and helped to carry out the rescue of the marooned member of the party, shod with dancing pumps, their only footgear, apart from gum-boots. A cool performance, but these unorthodox proceedings add zest to the narrative, and one is at pains which most to admire, the common sense of the author, the dash and drive of the leader, or the imperturbability of Hugh. A few photographs for the benefit of non-Scottish and non-climbing readers would not have been amiss, and a sixfold mis-spelling of a German word in the misquotation of the first line or so of a German ditty on page 175 will not detract from the enjoyment of the general reader. There is many a chuckle of laughter in the book.

There was a long drawn out controversy with Dr. Robert Brown on the question of the publication of a book and in a letter from Copenhagen, dated October 26, 1867, Whymper wrote to him as follows:—

‘ . . . I will tell you what my views are in regard to a book, and you will then be enabled to put your proposition with such exactness as will enable me to give a clear reply.’

My opinion of the voyage is:—

1. That geographically it is an utter failure.
2. That physically it is interesting.
3. That in collections it is to a certain extent valuable.
4. It is entirely destitute of excitement.
5. That artistically it is moderately good.

These are the points which determine men to publish, or which influence publishers to take books . . .’
