

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ALPINE CLUB

A GENERAL MEETING of the Club was held in the Hall, 74 South Audley Street, London, W. 1, on Tuesday, May 7, 1946, at 6.30 P.M., the Rt. Hon. L. S. Amery, C.H., *President*, in the Chair.

The PRESIDENT made the following announcements :

1. That the following candidates had been elected members of the Club, namely, Messrs. H. St. V. Longley-Cook, P. J. Markbreiter and C. D. Milner, and that Mr. J. M. K. Vyvyan had been re-elected to membership.
2. That a letter had been received from the Czechoslovakian Alpine Club inviting a party of from ten to fifteen members of the A.C. to visit the Tatra Mountains this summer, for whom all arrangements as to accommodation, provisions, etc., would be made. It was hoped that some of the members would find it possible to accept this invitation.

Dr. N. E. Odell, Vice-President, conveyed greetings from the Norsk Tindeklub of Oslo, with whom he had recently been in contact.

Major J. Waller, D.S.O., M.C., exhibited his film of the 1938 Masherbrum expedition. There was a large audience.
